PALCI Membership Criteria & Supplemental Application Materials

Approved by the Board on September 19, 2023

PALCI's primary mission is to enable cost-effective and sustainable access to information resources and services for academic libraries in Pennsylvania and surrounding states. The PALCI partnership is grounded in resource sharing among diverse partners, where resource sharing is broadly defined to include the sharing of collections, both physical and electronic, people and expertise, technology, innovation, and library infrastructure, as well as the sharing of financial and other resources to further meet the evolving needs of partner institutions. See PALCI Strategic Outline for information about how the consortium approaches its work.

PALCI membership is open to all not-for-profit academic institutions (4-year/baccalaureate) and not-for-profit research libraries that are located within Pennsylvania and contiguous states.

Upon joining, each member library retains autonomy over its staff, operations, and budget. However, membership in PALCI requires collaboration and commitment to the PALCI partnership, demonstrated through active engagement in and support for PALCI initiatives, programs, and services to the fullest extent possible.

The PALCI membership committee reviews all member applications for alignment with PALCI's mission, vision, and values, and takes into consideration the institution's stated goals, as well as PALCI's evaluating criteria. Applicants should address each of the criteria categories in their application with a demonstration of capacity for and willingness to participate for fullest consideration. PALCI evaluating criteria was designed to support the committee's ability to understand the applicant's potential for value derived from PALCI, as well as the value and contributions the applicant will make to the partnership.

Applications recommended by the Membership Committee will be made available for comment to all PALCI voting representatives, followed by a vote by the Board per PALCI's membership application process (available at https://palci.org/about/members/apply).

Identifying the Value of PALCI: Success Indicators & Evaluation Criteria for PALCI Membership Applications Considerations for self-evaluation by applicants and prospective PALCI members

The PALCI Membership Committee strives to strategically admit institutions that will support bi-directional, mutual value propositions to the PALCI partnership. The categories below are designed to support the applicant in considering the value of PALCI membership for your library as you develop your library's application, and to support the Membership Committee in evaluating and anticipating applicants' ability to both derive value from and contribute value to PALCI's partnership.

At a minimum, each new partnering institution must have:

- At least one full-time library employee with an accredited advanced degree in library science or an equivalent related advanced degree, as well as
- An integrated library system (ILS) or equivalent system that is able to interface with PALCI's EZBorrow resource sharing platform

Each category below is broken down into specific aspects to further elicit detail and feedback from applicants.

NOTE: The categories below are <u>not</u> intended to serve as membership requirements. There is <u>no</u> expectation that all member institutions will be able to demonstrate or excel in all areas outlined below. Rather, PALCI aims to aid prospective members in completing their applications by articulating the value their institutions seek and bring to membership, and to support the membership committee in articulating and identifying how diverse institutions will bring different strengths to the PALCI collaboration.

Applicants are asked to address all questions in the application, and to address any perceived challenges your organization may face in fully participating or contributing value to PALCI in the context of the areas outlined below.

1. Alignment of institutional priorities with PALCI's mission, vision, values and current or anticipated programs/services

Consider and demonstrate the ways your library /institution aligns with PALCI values and approaches in your statement of interest or other library-provided materials included in your application. If applicable, why/how is PALCI perceived to be distinctive from your other consortial membership options?

2. Budget & Finance

Consider/Discuss your library's:

- Ability to sustainably support PALCI membership dues
- Capacity to participate in optional strategic collaboration programs and offerings

3. Collections Sharing

Consider/Discuss your library's:

- Commitment to loading holdings into EZB shared index, updating at least 1-2x annually or more
- Evidence of shareable physical collections
- Staff capacity for resource sharing functions
- Technical/Systems capacity for resource sharing integrations with EZBorrow
- Budgetary capacity for and interest in other resource sharing channels e.g., RapidILL participation
- Staff capacity for participation in resource sharing committees by staff (e.g. monthly online meetings)

4. Licensing and Participation in Strategic Collaborative Collections Efforts

Consider/Discuss your library's:

- Sufficient budget and organizational support available for participation in strategic group licensing/content curation via PALCI (1 offering per year)
- Sufficient/steady/growing budget for materials
- Demonstrated interest, willingness, and plans to participate in strategic collaborative collections offerings
- Staff capacity to consider strategic offers, and participate in feedback gathering exercises and collections community conversations

5. Library Innovation & Community-owned/Open Infrastructure

Consider/Discuss your library's:

- Capacity, interest, and willingness to take part in PALCI innovation efforts, e.g., Hyku pilot, CCLP, developing new licensing modalities and business models, etc
- Support for or participation in innovative initiatives
